 - (2) The recipient must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3;
 - (3) The recipient must have a letter of recommendation from a full time faculty member and must complete the application included below;
 - (4) Women in MEPS who are of Middle Eastern origin are strongly encouraged to apply.
