Housing/Room Accommodations

Carrollton Hall is an upperclass residence hall completed in 1999. The suites consist of two bedrooms, a living room (common area) and a bathroom. Each conference attendee will share a suite but have a private room.

All rooms in Carrollton Hall come with adjustable room temperature controls, movable furniture, basic cable and ethernet/wireless Internet.

Laundry services are available in Carrollton, along with coin-operated vending machines. The lobby area includes seating and TV viewing.

Provided for each conference attendee is a set of linens for the bed, one pillow, one bath towel and washcloth, along with shampoo and hand soap. You may want to bring an additional pillow or towels. Hair dryers are not provided.

Sports Complex use

The university's sports complex (the Rec Plex) is located near Carrollton and features:

- six-lane, Olympic-style swimming pool
- whirlpool
- elevated jogging track
- sauna and steam rooms in each locker room
- indoor tennis courts*
- separate free weight and fitness rooms
- racquetball courts*
- maple-floored courts for basketball and volleyball
- aerobics and multi-purpose rooms
- stairmasters, stationary bikes, spinners, rowers, elliptical trainers and treadmills
- locker rental and towel service
- sports equipment check-out
