Robert R.M. Verchick holds the Gauthier-St. Martin Chair in Environmental Law at Loyola University New Orleans. He is also a Senior Fellow at Tulane University's <u>Disaster Resilience Leadership Academy</u>, in the School of Social Work, and President of the <u>Center for Progressive Reform</u>, a national policy institute focused on public health, public welfare, and environmental protection. Professor Verchick served in the Obama administration as Deputy Associate Administrator for Policy at the <u>U.S. Environmental Protection Agency</u> in 2009 and 2010, where he helped develop climate adaptation policy for the EPA and served on President Obama's <u>Interagency Climate Change Adaptation Task Force</u>. Professor Verchick has testified before Congress several times and represented environmental interests in friend-of-the-court briefs in cases before the U.S. Supreme Court and the federal appellate courts. His writing focuses on environmental regulation, climate change adaptation, and the developing field of disaster law.
