Nominations

Nominations will be solicited once per year in the spring semester. Nominations may be submitted by any member of the College of Arts and Sciences. A letter of nomination should include the nominee's position, department and reasons for nomination.

Criteria for Selection

- 1. A full-time staff member within the College of Arts and Sciences.
- 2. Superior performance in one's position above is required.
- 3. Contribution to making one's department/program and/or the College as a whole responsive, supportive and friendly to students, staff, faculty and other university members.

Eligibility

- 1. Any full-time staff member of the College of Arts and Sciences.
- 2. The recipient must be employed by Loyola for at least one year prior to being nominated for this award.
- 3. Staff members may receive this award more than once in their career at Loyola.

Award Selection Procedure

- 1. No member of the selection committee may nominate staff for the award.
- 2. No member of the selection committee may write supporting letters for nominees.
- 3. Committee members may not vote on nominees from their own department.
- 4. The Committee will open nominations, organize nominee materials, coordinate the selection committee meeting(s) and notify winners of the award prior to the Honors Convocation.
- 5. The following items shall remain confidential: names of nominees, number of nominees, all supporting materials for nominees and committee discussions and voting.

Nominee Support Material

The nominator is responsible for submitting a letter of nomination along with other letters of support for consideration by the selection committee.

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will consist of two CAS unit leaders, a staff member from outside the College and a Dean's Student Advisory Committee (DSAC) representative.

Winner will receive \$1,000.
