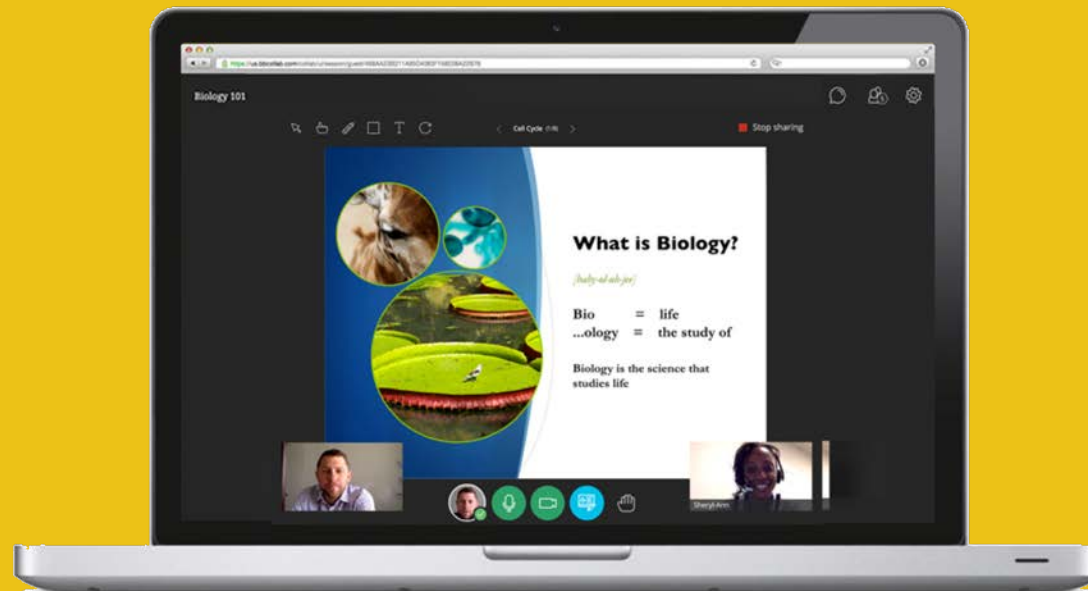

# Ultra View

- New and improved presentation intended to improve the navigation of the original course view
- Does not change any of the processes within the course
- Examples:
  1. Navigation bar. Open frequently used tools in one step. Select an icon to check the course calendar, respond to class discussions, access the course gradebook, and send a message.
  2. Add content. Select the plus sign wherever you want to add content. If you want to copy or import content, select the More options icon next to the Books and Tools link. In a new, blank course, use the functions to add content, such as Create and Upload.
