CMFA Independent Study

A student may apply for an independent study only in the following two cases:

- 1. The student needs a course for graduation which is not presently being offered, or
- 2. The student desires to study a topic(s) not covered in courses offered by the college.

An overall GPA of 2.0 is required in order to be eligible to enroll in independent study. In general, students applying for independent study should possess at least junior standing. Exceptions must be discussed with and approved by the associate dean. Students must also complete a formal application prior to registration and obtain approval from the desired **tenured** instructor and the CMFA Associate Dean. In addition, the following course information must accompany the Loyola New Orleans Independent Study Registration Form:
