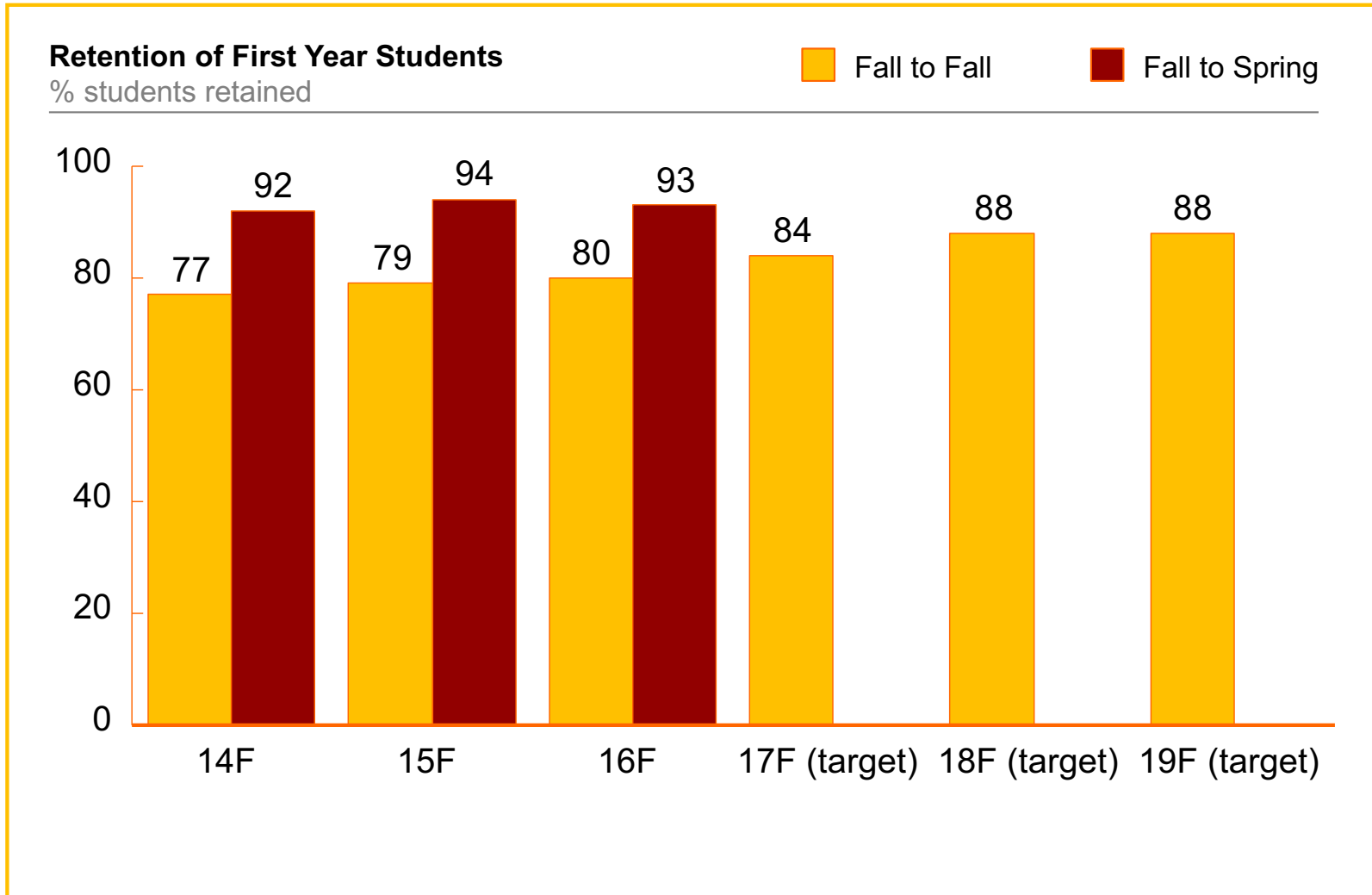

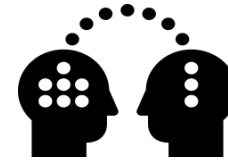

Develop, not Tell

Topics Covered in One Meeting This Semester

- Student struggling with lecturing style
 - Went to **office hours**, got a better understanding of how to take notes
 - Discussed doing this in the **future**
- Student rarely had time to make it to OR for dinner
 - Talked about **scheduling time** to grocery shop including travel to and from
- Student made a **GPA goal** of 3.6
 - Noted that grades aren't always in his control
 - Discussed **making goals you can control** like “never miss an assignment”
- Student stated he needed to “study more”
 - Discussed **quality of study time vs. quantity**
- Student had trouble fitting his tasks into one day
 - Pointed him toward a **scheduling app**
- Student expressed that **drawing for pleasure was important to him**
 - Discussed using his planner to schedule personal tasks alongside schoolwork
